In addition to the discretionary amount in the above table, the FY2021 President's budget request proposed \$4.21 billion in mandatory funding for the CCDF. The mandatory funding proposal included a new one-time fund of \$1 billion aimed at building the supply of child care for underserved populations and to stimulate employer investment in child care.
